DISTANCE HORSE OF THE YEAR AWARD NOMINATION

The award is a walnut plaque with a facsimile of a bronze sculpture by Joe Staheli that immortalizes the distance horse. The award will be presented for a significant accomplishment in the distance sports as determined by the Distance Horse of the Year Committee. The original sculpture is a perpetual trophy that will remain on display at the AHA office with yearly winners engraved on its base.

Any AHA member can nominate a horse for the award. The owner of the horse nominated must also be an AHA member. Nomination deadline is September 1.

Horses enrolled in AHA programs MUST be registered with the Arabian Horse Association or Canadian Registries. Refer to the current Handbook for membership requirements and for specific rules, regulations and deadlines, or call the AHA office.
