From the President's Paddock...

This year I'm thinking about Convention a lot earlier since we're deeply involved in all the details of planning right now, and it's gotten me to thinking about how much goes on that I never paid much attention to before. With so much activity packed into just a couple of days, you really don't want to miss out on all the opportunities this annual gathering offers. So: here are some tips on how to get the most out of your Convention. First, renew your membership ahead of time, (chance at a Free Ride Entry!). Second, go immediately to the registration table after you check in to the hotel and pick up the Schedule of Events. This

is your guide to everything that's happening throughout the weekend. The Trade Show

opens at noon on Friday and I'd suggest shopping right away so you have time for the social events on Friday night. If you can't come in until Saturday, it's even more important that you register asap. Registration will CLOSE at 2:30 (as well as during the presentations) on Saturday, so make sure to get your membership and tickets for the banquet before then. Check out the preliminary schedule in this newsletter. Another tip: bring your own lunch fixin's (fridge and micro in room) if you want to save some money. Breakfast is already covered, and Saturday night you'll attend the awards banquet (fabulous food by the way - we went down recently for a "tasting"). Finally: attend the General Meeting on Saturday afternoon. You'll find out what's happening in the organization, you can participate in voting for the President and Vice-President (Note: you must have renewed your membership prior to the meeting to be eligible to vote), and you can even become a member of the Board of Directors if you're so inclined. Rider Reps and Ride Manager Reps from each state/province are elected at the AGM as well. (Note: You must have been a PNER member for at least one year to be elected to the Board).

Raffle Update . . .

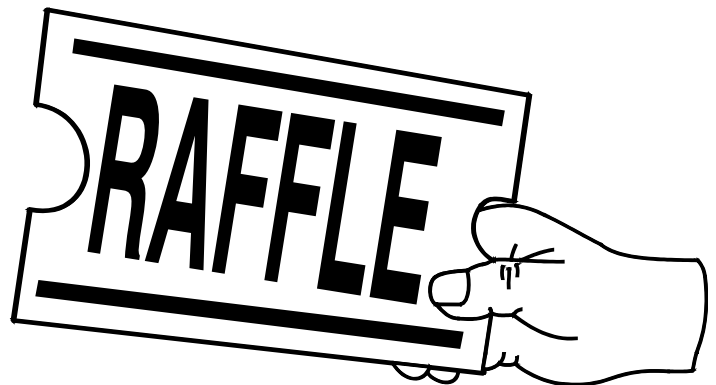

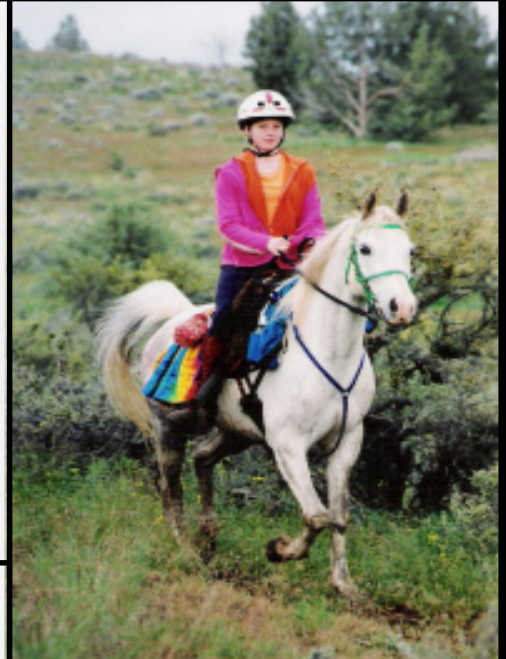
