From the President's Paddock...

From the "Vet Check".....

Well, some years just don't go as planned, and that about sums up the 2005 ride season for me so far. After putting Peek on "injured reserve" early in the season (for the first time ever) I tried to keep myself busy with other activities. Actually it's pretty amazing how busy you can keep yourself even without riding. It makes me wonder how we do manage to squeeze such a big chunk of time in our schedules. And I have a confession to make. My house wasn't really much cleaner. So much for the "I'm too busy conditioning" excuse. Of course, it wasn't long before a friend offered up her backup endurance horse that could use some conditioning, and more endurance rides. Ok! Now I have a mission again. But alas, it didn't last long. I went up to the NW Labor Day Ride a little early to help out, and got launched off Lil' Joe (Jeff's 19 year old endurance horse) and broke my hand. Well, I was up there to help out anyway, I guess it just wasn't going to be marking trail on horseback. At first, I still had delusions about riding - hey, you can heal a lot in two days, right? But Dr. Jen was at the ready to determine me mentally incompetent and/or conclude that whatever horse I brought to the vet-in was "lame". So, I set myself to figuring out what a one-handed endurance rider could do around camp. P&R seemed a little inefficient under the circumstances, so I chose Vet Scribe. (The person that writes down the vet's scores during the vet exam)

Although I've been through a lot of vet checks over the years, it really is different and fascinating seeing the whole ride from a vet's perspective. Watching several hundred trot outs all in one day is really interesting and challenging. Determining whether a horse is "fit to continue" is sometimes a lot more

difficult than you'd think. As the day wears on and the horses get tired, even more so. Is it just this horse's gait, or is he really off? And speaking of gaits, when it came to the gaited horses, I was pretty lost. It's pretty tough for most of the vets too. It's just a matter of familiarity. Unless you see a lot and really know what looks right, how do you know what looks wrong? It will get easier as more gaited horses enter rides, but in the meantime, have patience. One of the things I saw a lot of was great feedback from the vets when a horse had some issues, but still able to continue. There were tips and suggestions, and a genuine effort to help the horse turn the corner in the right direction. I also saw compassion when the decision was not to go on, as well as more than one hug when riders needed it, because the trail had just taken its toll. And when there was time, the vets tried to diagnose and recommend treatment for issues that ended the ride early for some. One of the vets (Jerry) even set aside time to talk with a young girl and her family about tying up syndrome and how to increase the chances of avoiding it in the future. As riders, we only see a small piece of what's going on at the vet check. We never see the extent to which our vets are committed to working together to help horse and rider to a completion. We've all heard them say it, and although I've always believed it, now I've really seen it in action, center stage.

On a personal note, I want to thank all the vets for taking care of me, especially Dr. Jen, the "Ice Queen" for coercing me to ice my hand, (Do you know how much it hurts to leave your hand in a bucket of ice water for ten minutes?), and Jerry, for saving me from the Ice Queen, by offering to engineer a new splint and sling for me. It worked great. With any luck, (ok, I want Good luck this time), Peek and I will be back on the trail for Dust Devil.

I don't know about you, but I spend all my extra time and money on the horses and going racing -- leaving no time, money or inclination to go on 'vacation.' Because of this, I am a fairly lazy person in camp. This is my R&R time and I want to make the most of it. Here are a few camp tips I would like to share.

Bring empty grain sacks from home. They are much sturdier than plastic trash bags and will stay open while you fill them with manure. You can start filling them up right away -- before it becomes real work. After it has been pulverized all weekend, nobody wants to clean it up -- especially not the ride management!

Bring your own horse water with you. You don't have to worry about water tanks being empty or too far away. You only have to carry buckets about 5 feet.

Bring a BLACK hard plastic (not rubber) bucket. Fill it with your water and set it where the sun will shine on it all day Saturday. When you are done with the ride, you have a bunch of VERY warm water to use to clean up your best friend who carried you all day. How would you like a COLD water bath as a reward?

For those of us that don't have microwaves and generators with us, here is an easy meal preparation tip. Make all dinners in advance at home or save leftovers and store in the freezer. For any meal that you would have to put in a pan, heat and stir to serve (soup, stew, chicken/noodles, goulash, stroganoff, etc.), place individual servings into FREEZER ziplock bags, sealing all the air out. Example: Broccoli Beef Stir-Fry and rice in separate bags. Or if you're having something more elaborate (enchaladas, rice and beans), make up your dinner in Glad storage containers, one container per serving. Put the Glad container in a FREEZER ziplock, sealing out all the air. Then, while you are cleaning up your buddy with all that ready-made warm water, put a large pot, 1/2 full of water on the stove to boil. When it boils, turn it off or as low as it will go. Put your bags of food (not frozen) into the hot water and put the lid on the pot. Do not overfill. Proceed to the next tip.

Break out that set of TV trays that you just can't get rid of -- set out the chips and dip (up high off the ground where the dogs won't get into it), and have a cocktail while you wait for your dinner to get hot. TV tray takes up less space and works better than an over-turned muck bucket.

Fifteen minutes later, dinner is served and NO DISHES!

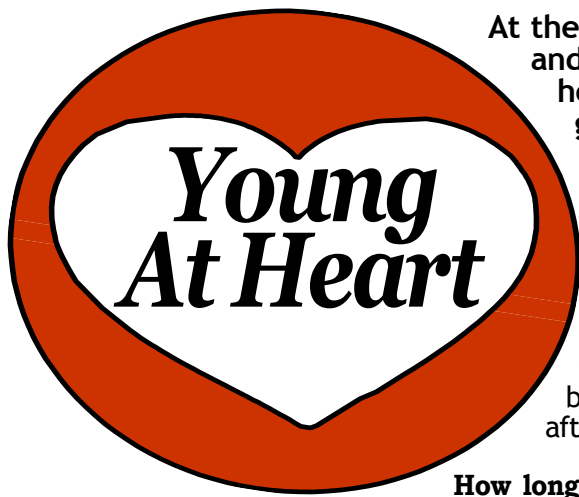

At the young age of 70, Kathleen Yielding is relatively new to this sport and she can be very inspiring to even much younger riders. She drives herself to rides, sets up and cleans up camp by herself and takes great care of her horse. You will always see her around ridecamp smiling and cracking a great joke. She has had to overcome physical limitations but that has not stopped her from her dream, to do endurance. She inspires the younger riders who know her well.

Kathleen, how long have you been riding/involved with horses?

Since I was a girl scout. I was a city kid born to a mom and dad who never imagined a horse in their life, but they had a daughter who could not imagine life without a horse. My mom was sure she brought the wrong baby home from the hospital. My first badge in girl scouts was for Horses and after the badge was earned I stayed on as a hang around kid at the stables.

How long have you been doing endurance and what made you start this sport?

Back in the early 70s I was a volunteer and vet scribe for some local rides. We were already showing POAs at that point but I liked the idea of "To finish is to win" so when I had a chance I finally entered my little POA mare in a 25 mile ride in Cherry Grove. The 25 miles were actually 35 miles and the old Stubben saddle I was riding in rubbed the inside of my

knees raw. I thought I'd never do that again. Instead I bought a Frost Endurance saddle to fit my mare and went to the Flying M ride the next year. I never raced. I finished.

What have been the challenges you've had to overcome riding at your age or just doing endurance altogether?

I started getting interested in trying endurance again around 2000 (65 yrs of age). My first challenge was getting rid of constant headaches-arthritis in my neck. In 2001 I had two discs replaced. Again, arthritis reared its head and by December 2002 I had a total right knee replacement. I was back on my horse in two months and at my first 25 mile ride by June 2003. I was waaay overtime but we did finish. After that ride Maxi (Arabian mare) came into my life and we entered Foothills of the Cascades that fall and finished within the time limit. In 2004 I entered 5 rides taking some time in the spring for arthroscopic surgery on the left knee (here we go again!). After Dust Devil it was back to the doctors. This time I insisted they just replace the darn thing so I could get back to riding sooner.

Have you had anyone in your life that thought you couldn't do this sport or tried to talk you out of it?

My knee surgeon had a fit after the first knee replacement. He told me before the surgery that "Of course, you won't be riding horses anymore." My reply was, "That ain't gonna happen!" Once he found out I was back on the horses he didn't want to talk to me.

Do you worry about injuries? Bones tend to be more brittle, heal slower, etc as you get older. Any special diet/exercise or supplements you take?

I do worry about injuries. I don't bounce so I try to ride safe horses. Maxi and I have had a few unscheduled dismounts but she does not scare me and I'm usually right back up in the saddle. Well, slowly right back up

anyway. Mounting with my knees is not a pretty sight. I take lots of vitamins and have for 40 years. I do believe it helps slow the aging process. I wish I could say I had a special diet but I eat what I feel like. I use a treadmill plus a recumbent bike. I also add a little weight lifting for the upper body. One of my cautions about my age and infirmities is: I don't ride a horse until I have some idea of what they are like.

What is your favorite thing(s) about endurance riding?

The people, the horses and the trail. I love seeing what's around the next hill. Challenging myself to keep fit to keep my horse fit and finish the ride within the time allowed. I could do without the long drive to the rides but I sure love the camps and the trails after we're settled in. I usually go to the rides by myself but I get lots of help from Happy Hoofers team members. I couldn't ask for better friends and team mates.

What advice would you give someone getting into endurance that is older?

Don't try to go too fast and make sure you have a safe, well broke horse. Ride as often as you can even if it means getting a second horse so you don't wear out the main ride. Make sure your saddle fits you as well as your horse. If your doctor says it's ok to take drugs - take them. Work up to distances slowly. Ride an hour every other day at first. Up it to two hours when it doesn't hurt. When you and your horse can ride five hours on your local trails you certainly can ride a 25 mile ride. Make sure you exercise your legs so you can post for long distances. It's important to use your muscles all the time. They weren't kidding when they said, "Use it or lose it!" Anytime an older person has to lay off riding for any length of time it means starting back at square one again. But each time it's easier to catch up to where you were when you left off the last time.

How I Converted My Truck to Biodiesel

Perhaps you catch a whiff of what smells like French fries as my truck passes through ridecamp or maybe you see its "Powered by Biodiesel" bumper sticker. In either case, you may wonder, "what the heck is biodiesel?"

Simply put, biodiesel is a clean-burning diesel fuel made from pure vegetable oil. Chemically, it's composed of mono-alkyl esters of long chain fatty acids derived from vegetable oils. Biodiesel is *not* the same as raw or straight vegetable oil—although some diesel engines can be modified to run on straight vegetable oil as a fuel. Running a diesel engine on biodiesel does not require any conversions, modifications or additives—just fill and go!

Biodiesel also can be blended with or used interchangeably with traditional petroleum diesel in any proportion. Because it's heavier than petrol-diesel, however, it's best to dispense biodiesel on top of petroleum diesel when you're blending yourself. Often you'll find biodiesel pre-blended at the pump. The blend of biodiesel is described in percentages. For example, 100 percent biodiesel is sold as B100, while a blend of 20 percent biodiesel and 80 percent petroleum diesel is known as B20, etc. Biodiesel has a higher lubricity than petroleum diesel, resulting in better engine performance. As a cleaner-burning fuel, biodiesel will dissolve and clean petroleum sediments from your vehicle's fuel tank, fuel line and engine. Because of this, it is recommended that you change your engine's fuel filter after the first tank of biodiesel.

I started experimenting with varying biodiesel blends about a year and a half ago in my 1994 F250 turbo diesel. When I "upgraded" to a 2002 F350 Powerstroke last January, I started running straight B100—unless travels take me out of biodiesel distribution ranges. In Oregon, biodiesel is available in at least a dozen locations from Portland through the Willamette Valley/I-5 corridor, nearly to the California border. It's also sold in Bend and Hood River. Western Washington also has numerous biodiesel dealers, and there's one in Spokane. In some areas, you can have a large tank of biodiesel delivered to your house. Although at this time, biodiesel has very limited distribution in Idaho (Driggs) and Montana (Missoula and West Yellowstone), it's a good bet that its availability will increase as petroleum prices rise.

Because it's non-toxic, 100 percent biodegradable and has more than twice the flash point temperature of petroleum diesel, pure biodiesel does not require hazardous storage precautions and does not have to be sold through gas stations. Look for it in unusual places. In Bend, a car wash sells biodiesel; in southern Oregon you can fill up at a garden store.

As of mid-September B99 was selling for about \$3.16 a gallon (Eugene) and B20 was going for \$3.11 per gallon (cardlock station in Portland). Unlike the many out-of-our-control factors (hurricanes, Middle East turmoil, etc.) that impact petroleum prices, biodiesel is produced from agricultural crops grown in the United States and "refined" in an increasing number of regional facilities. While driving hundreds of miles for your next ride you can feel good about creating new markets for American farm products, creating new jobs in local communities and keeping money in our domestic economy! Additionally, biodiesel is created from renewable crops, such as corn and soybeans, which absorb carbon dioxide through their growing process.

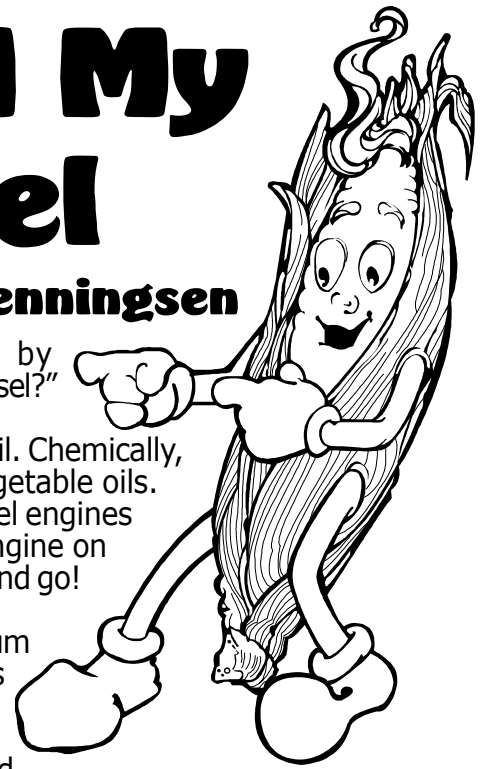
From a health and environmental perspective, exhaust emissions of sulfur oxides and sulfates (major components of acid rain) are completely eliminated with biodiesel. Exhaust emissions (think of your trailered horse breathing tailpipe smoke) of aromatic compounds known as PAH and NPAH compounds (suspected of causing cancer) are reduced from 75 to 90 percent compared to regular diesel. Most other "harmful" emissions are significant with biodiesel as well.

While biodiesel isn't as "clean" as hydrogen fuel cell technology or the best energy solution, it's an alternative that's affordable, easy, available—and can run our trucks until better technology is available.

Biodiesel Considerations

Natural Rubber

• Pure biodiesel will degrade any natural rubber parts (i.e. hoses and seals) in your fuel delivery system. Generally, natural rubber parts only appear in vehicles manufactured before 1993. After 1993, most engine manufacturers began using synthetic rubber or metal parts exclusively. The following parts are also adversely affected by pure biodiesel: Nitrile, Polypropylene, Polyvinyl, Tygon, and Fluorosilicon. These materials should be replaced with the following materials: Teflon, Nylon6/6, Viton A401-C and Viton GFLT. Check with your mechanic or dealer if you aren't sure what's in your truck.

Cold Weather

Like any diesel fuel, biodiesel can gel at low temperatures. When temperatures fall below 40 degrees, it is recommended that you blend biodiesel with at least 50 percent petroleum. Yellowstone National Park, The University of Idaho and the Montana Department of Environmental Quality first pioneered biodiesel with the "Truck in the Park Program." The project placed an unaltered diesel pickup truck into service in Yellowstone National Park, fueled the truck with 100 percent rapeseed ethyl ester, and monitored performance and emissions. The program started in 1995 and has since demonstrated biodiesel use in all weather conditions while covering over 160,000 miles of operation. Closer to home, Oregon's Hoodoo Ski Area uses a B10 blend in its snowcats, front loaders, generators, and trucks.

Manufacturer Warranties

Although biodiesel is one of the most thoroughly tested alternative fuels on the market and is widely used in municipal fleets, many National Parks, and U.S. Postal vehicles in a growing number of areas, there is conflicting information on how its use could impact a vehicle's warranty. The National Biodiesel Board states that the use of biodiesel in existing diesel engines does not void parts and materials workmanship warranties of any major U.S. engine manufacturer. However, a number of automobile and truck manufacturers, at this time, do not endorse fuels that contain more than 5 percent biodiesel. If you have warranty concerns, check with your truck dealer and/or manufacturer before using biodiesel.

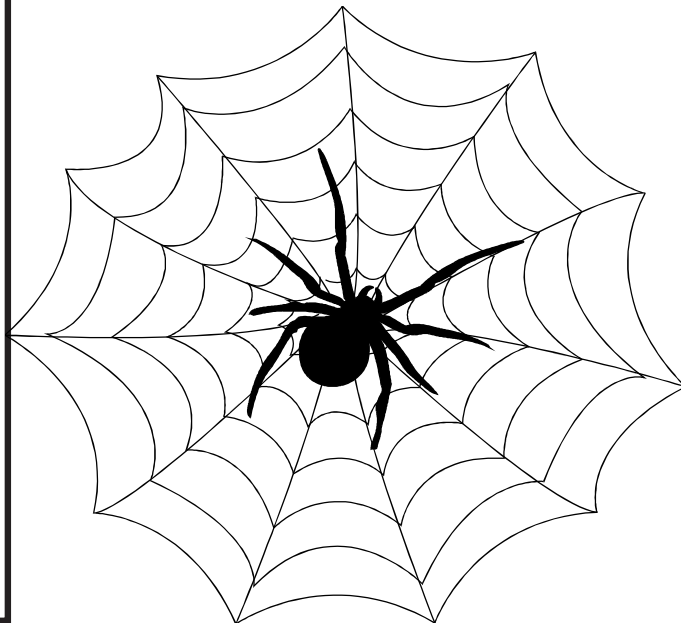
