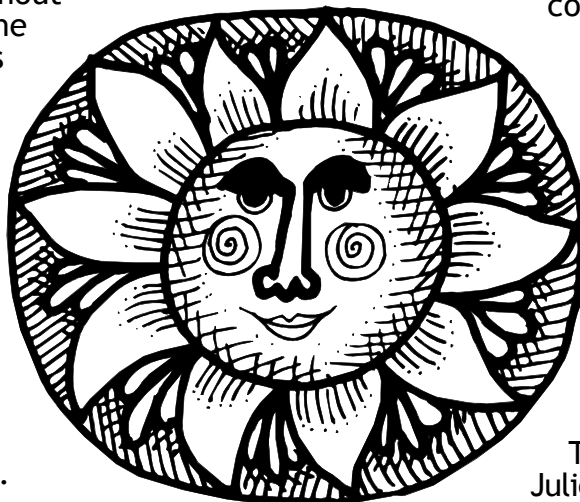

From the President's Paddock...

I hope all of you are well into enjoying your ride season and most importantly, having fun with it. I'm getting a bit of a slow start this year, for various reasons, but am on my way to Klickitat Trek for my second ride of the season and am excited about the prospect of a good ride with good friends and great stories. The weather could be better at the moment. As we're headed through Ellensburg in a pretty steady downpour, I'm watching the windshield wipers in their rhythmic pattern clear our way for just a moment, then all is blurry again. Hope I brought enough raingear. Actually, there are all kinds of things to keep the mind busy on the way to the ride. Did I bring enough horse blankets, hay, etc? Have I conditioned enough? What's my ride strategy? What distance am I going to do? (Ok, so we should have already figured this one out at this point, but we know that's not always the case). Will that change if it keeps raining? Should I go for Top Ten or just have fun? Lately I've just done the latter. I've had a lot of rides with very specific agendas and strategies, but for the last couple of years I've just gone to enjoy the trail and experience. It makes for a relaxing adventure. Not as exciting to be sure, but still a lot of fun without the added pressure. I do miss the adrenaline rush of working towards and accomplishing a more difficult challenge, but it's always there when I'm ready to get back to it. But when life gets too stressful, I can just use a ride weekend as therapy. It's amazing the perspective you can get out on the trails riding mile after mile with your equine companion. Which makes me think about how important our trails really are. Not just to our sport, but to our sanity as well.



What if we didn't have the opportunity to get out and ride long enough to get our saddle pad wet? We all realize that trails are important. But what are we doing about it? Our Trails Masters course is coming up June 8th in Naches, WA sponsored by AERC and graciously hosted by Gail Williams. This is an opportunity for a few to become stewards of trail building practices, and hopefully share these new skills with others (especially ride managers!) Jerry Fruth, our AERC Trails "Guru" has suggested that we commit to 20 hours a year to helping trails. That could be promoting, building, maintaining, protecting or whatever suits you. I think this is reasonable. Now, I know all of our ride managers are putting in at least that much time, so you're off the hook here, although I hope that you're sharing your concerns and knowledge that you've gained from all your efforts with the rest of us. We rely so much on trails just being there, it's time to ask yourself what you've done to help them. Maybe it's in your own "back yard". It was for me. When I moved to Redmond (WA) with my horses, I was concerned about the stability of the trails system I relied on so much for my conditioning. So I became involved with the local horse council, and then ultimately part of a volunteer trails commission which advises the city council and mayor on trail issues and opportunities. We've been successful in protecting and improving many trails in the area, including the ones I use for training. Just an example of what you can do. So ask yourself - Have I helped a trail this month? Could I put in 20 hours a year to this cause? Can I make a difference? I think so. I hope you do too.

The response from the membership was somewhat under-whelming, not surprisingly (I think we got two e-mails). I think most folks a) always thought we were an established non-profit or b) don't understand the significance of the designation or c) were too busy riding to care.

Folks, this is a BIG DEAL. It is also a demonstration that volunteerism is alive and well, and it is what makes this organization work. Sky Evans wrote a great article last month talking about all the volunteers who make an endurance ride happen—I'm going to piggy-back on that thought and remind you all of the hard work your elected and appointed PNER officials are doing on your behalf.

To register PNER as a non-profit, Julie donated HOURS of her time and expertise as a

CPA to put together an application of over thirty pages for submission to the IRS. She consulted with lawyers, AERC, and other CPA's to guide her in the process. She researched old records, read old minutes, dug up old history that none of us "had time" to do. For those of us who only interact with the IRS once a year, you gotta know that doing this for an organization like PNER, with the prospect of possibly thousands of dollars in back taxes being levied IF the application is rejected, this is a BIG DEAL.

We are so fortunate that we have people like Julie with real skills in the real world to help us through this. If we had hire out to get this important task done, I firmly believe we would not have had the quality of work and care that Julie put into this, and it would have cost us thousands of dollars in legal and CPA fees. Yep, Julie's my friend, so maybe I'm biased. But I'm also glad she's the President of this organization. So thanks.

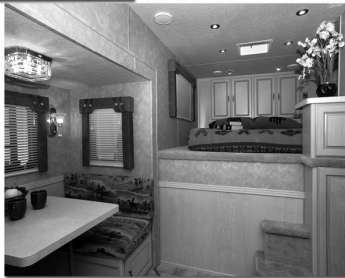

RIDE OVER THE RAINBOW

30, 50, 100 MILE RIDES

Saturday
JULY 1st, 2006



Ride Over Rainbows in British Columbia! This challenging trail, on and around the **Coutlee Plateau Southwest of Merritt**, includes 8,900' of vertical gain over 10 miles on logging roads and cow and game trails. Views are of four separate valleys and mountain ranges. Start and finish lines are at base camp with an 'out' vet check for the 100 mile ride. The winning time for the 100 mile ride in 2004 was 13 hours; the 50 mile ride was 5 hours. Base camp is a remote forestry camp with no amenities. It is, however, easily accessible by truck and horse trailer and large/long rigs!

These rides are sponsored by the Endurance Riders Association of B.C. and are benefit rides to raise funds to help send B.C. riders to International Events. All rides are run under AERC rules with additional ERABC rules for the 30 mile ride. . Sunday morning Eggs Benny is included in your entry fee (\$5.00 per plate for non-riders).

Entry Fees: 30 miles \$55; 50 miles \$85; 100 miles \$135 Canadian funds; add \$15 for entries after June 20; Juniors (and their sponsors) receive 10% off. Please call for complete fee schedule.

Directions: From Southwest: Take Highway 1 to Hope then Highway 5 through the toll booth (\$10 CDN). 33 K's past the toll booth take the Coldwater Road exit. Proceed west on Coldwater Road for 12 K's; turn Left onto Patchet Road (gravel); just past the 6K marker turn right up a steep single lane dirt road for 2K's into camp. From Southeast: Take Highway 97 to Highway 97C which goes into Merritt. Just before entering the town turn Left onto Coldwater Road. Proceed south for 18 k's to Patchet Road; turn Right and proceed as above. From North: Take Highway 5 south to Merritt and use the 2nd exit. Proceed as above after turning Left onto Coldwater Road.

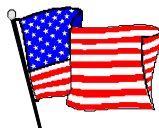
