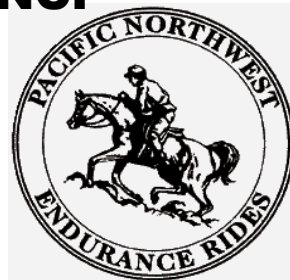
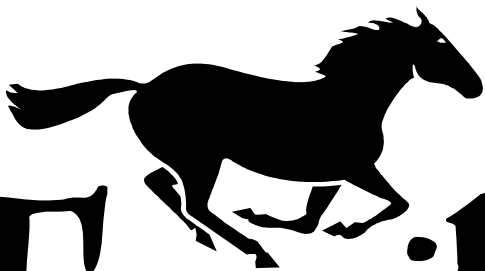

From the President's Paddock...

We all know that Ride Managers are saints (as well as gluttons for punishment) and appreciate all that they do, but I think many of our PNER members don't realize how many volunteers it really takes to put on a ride, and that ride managers are really at the mercy of our collective efforts. If you've ever come into a vet check with an ugly-long line and blamed ride management for not being organized, think again. This is generally a direct result of not getting enough volunteers to cover all the "bases". Recruiting and organizing volunteers is one of the toughest jobs for a ride manager, and even if a ride has had good numbers in the past, family and friends get burned out. They constantly need new people to step up to the plate. A recent example is the Sunriver Ride. This event is particularly difficult to manage because of all the out vet checks. That's done to create a wonderful 50-mile loop - for the riders' benefit. Prior to this year's ride, Ride Management sent out several pleas for volunteers but still came up short. It's just getting more and more difficult to find people. Yes, many did jump in at the last minute who were there crewing, etc and that was greatly appreciated, but it's so stressful on the managers not knowing what they have to count on. I'd like to see us all take a little more responsibility in keeping these rides going. Yes, I really mean that. We will lose rides if there aren't enough people who volunteer. So, I have a suggestion, and a proposal. First, the suggestion: Pick one ride a year, leave your horse home, and just volunteer to help at that ride. Make sure you contact the Ride Manager in advance so they know they can count on you. It will even be fun, really. And for a proposal....our esteemed VP, Sandy and I have been talking about how volunteering at rides should be more of an intrinsic part of PNER membership and have come up with one more crazy idea. How about making it a part of the team points competition? Each team could select a ride to cover one aspect of that ride. For example, take over registration responsibilities for a ride, or "sponsor" one Vet Check and take care of P&R, timing and vet scribing. You could show your team spirit (if you want) by creating a theme for that Vet Check and make it fun for everyone. It won't take the whole team's attendance to make this work, and if you have some new members on your team, what a great learning experience for them! Bonus points could be awarded in the team competition for teams that participated in this way. It's just a proposal, but the underlying message is important. It takes help and cooperation from all of us to keep our sport thriving. Let me know what you think.

We talk a lot about "our equine partners." What does that really mean? In the last 15 years or so, I've gotten into the habit of pushing myself physically in order to experience something similar to what I think my horse does. Why? I figure it's worthwhile to understand how it feels to go when you don't want to, further than you would like to, and learn to draw from deep inside in order to keep going. It's been fun, mostly. Through running and triathlons, I've discovered what it feels like to go out too fast and be wiped out by mid-day. I've learned what it takes to keep going—no matter how bad you feel. I've felt exhilarated by being in shape, and angry at myself when I end up packing a few (ok, more than a few) extra pounds on a race and feeling crummy because it just wears you out. I've felt that half-way point, when you are not sure you are EVER going to get through. I've also felt that close-to-the-finish-line-this-is-amazing-I-DID it feeling, and that marvelous high that comes with knowing you trained enough and in the right way.

I think there's a lot to be said for pushing yourself in some manner; if nothing else it gives you a great respect for what we ask of our horses. But taking on personal challenges of any sort still gives insight to the process of training, learning, staying motivated, persevering, sticking with it, and seeing "it"—whatever that is—to the end, —in a word, it teaches us about *endurance*.

Compulsive Trail Maintenance Syndrome

Diagnosed in Northwest Endurance Riders

- Have you ever carried loppers to early-morning staff meetings?
- Have you ever calculated the average grade of the Walmart parking lot?
- Do you include trail equipment jargon into otherwise normal sentences? Example: "I think I'll take the dog and the Pulaski for a walk."
- Do you find yourself eyeing the sandbox at the local preschool, trying to figure out what the correct binding amendment would be if the box was placed on a slope of 5 to 10 degrees?
- Have you ever wondered how much trade-in value your truck would have towards the purchase of a new Ditch Witch diesel 650?
- Have your neighbors ever requested that you not clear 3 feet into their yard from the sidewalk?
- When you tell your family you're taking the dog for a walk, do they assume you will also take a Pulaski?



If you've answered YES to any of these questions, you may be suffering from Compulsive Trail Maintenance Syndrome. Compulsive Trail Maintenance Syndrome, (CTMS) is an incurable condition afflicting ride managers, endurance riders, and trail users of all types who have passed the Trails Masters course, causing them to look at trails with a new eye towards sustainability.



CTMS patients report an inability to concentrate when confronted with trails that violate the 50% rule. They feel a strong need to measure slope declinations, and a desperate yearning to re-route fall line trails onto sustainable contours.

Advanced CTMS cases will spend hours walking trails, checking and repairing back-slope issues, and will cheerfully spend countless evenings with land owners, park rangers, forestry reps, and anyone else who will listen to them talk about multi-use trails.

Recently, 7 PNER members who exhibit symptoms of Compulsive Trail Maintenance Syndrome gathered at the Naches Ranger Station for 4 days to learn efficient ways to design, build, and maintain our trails so that they don't wash away in the first rainstorm, blow away with the autumn leaves, or become ever-widening freeways in the wake of thousands of feet, tires, and hooves.

These Trail Masters are in the early stages of CTMS...and they want to help you help your trails. Be kind to them, won't you? Volunteer your time, donate money to trail maintenance projects, and educate yourself on the care of your local trails.

And when you have trails that need work—whether it's a swampy spot that just won't drain, a steep stretch that keeps washing out, or just an overgrown section of blackberry paths—invite a Trail Master to come and help you.

Because a Pulaski is a terrible thing to waste!

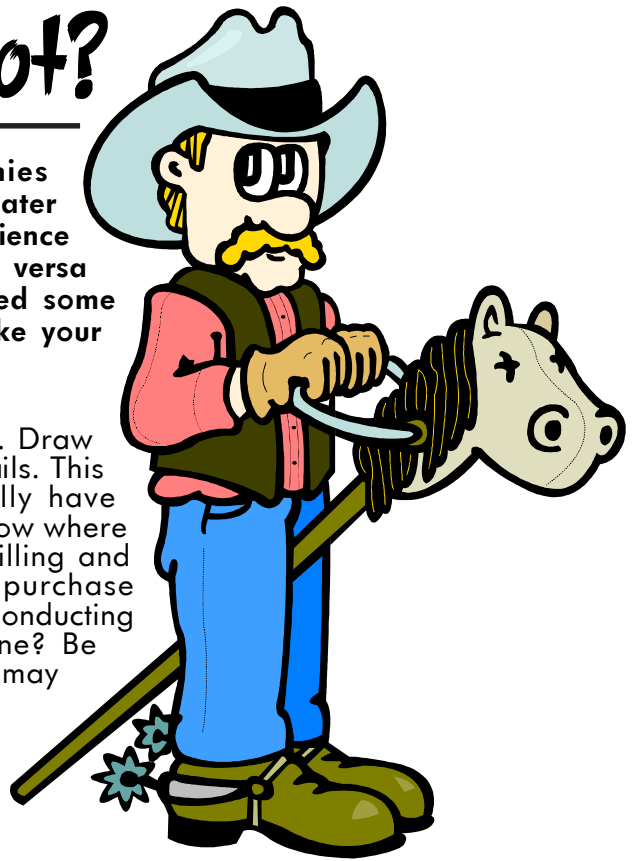

HORSE SHOPPING...OR NOT?

When I decided to embark on my "Dependable Ponies Delivered" odyssey I really had no idea what was to come later on. For the most part it has been a very rewarding experience and I'm always happy to see people find horses and vice versa that are a good fit. With that being said, I have learned some tidbits of knowledge I'd like to share, and hopefully make your horse shopping experience less stressful than necessary.



1. Know what you want in your next endurance horse. Draw that mental picture and then write down all the details. This way you aren't just "window shopping", you really have something specific in mind. In short, have a plan! Know where this horse will be living, the outside *most* you're willing and able to pay, whether you're going to do a pre-purchase examination or not, which veterinarian is going to be conducting the examination. Do you need a coggins test done? Be prepared to deal with any other small detail that may crop up.
2. Be flexible!! So your mentally pictured horse is bay, but the rest of your criteria just trotted up in a grey hide? Better look twice! Never know what you might pass up looking for the right paintjob.
3. Shopping online? Unbiased eyes see much, but they see much better "in person". Please do ask for pictures, but please, PUHLEEZE do not judge that horse too harshly based on photographs! A noted trainer and rider related to me once when I was venting about people who "photo shop" for horses, "I can make even the most crooked of horses look incredible in a picture." Well the same can be true from the opposite perspective, I for one, can make the most correct horse look crooked, evidently even club footed, in photographs! *Don't trust pictures alone*, and for goodness sake, if you're going to pass along these photographs someone you consider an expert in the field for a free evaluation, expect to get what you pay for. Understand that it's unreasonable for a professional in some remote corner of their world to make an educated guess about the horse you're looking to buy here. One really needs physically evaluate a horse. I can't emphasize this enough.
4. Find someone reputable and knowledgeable in your area and take them along, or send them out to evaluate this potential next endurance horse for/with you. This can be a friend or acquaintance who trains horses, a friend who has lots of endurance miles, but most of all someone who isn't going to let you be swayed by the really pretty hide on the horse! We sometimes get so wrapped up in what we "want to see" that we fail to see what's really in front of us. This is where that "unbiased" eye comes in to save the day. There are people in all corners of the Pacific Northwest that you can call or email, who would be happy to go and do a quick evaluation on a potential horse.
5. If you find "The Horse", be prepared to offer a deposit on said horse while you take care of the important details of setting up a pre-purchase examination, etc. This will hold the horse for a pre-determined amount of time and essentially remove it from the market for that time period. Generally a deposit should consist of half down, but can be an agreed to amount as well. Reasonably expect to offer about 15% of that deposit to the owner/agent if you decide against this horse. This person has just put in valuable time for you, showing you the horse, many times making arrangements on your behalf, etc. Their time is just as valuable as yours.
6. The Pre-Purchase Exam! I often get asked if this is really necessary. My rote answer tends to be, well, if you're paying more than \$2500 for a horse, you should consider having a pre-purchase examination done by someone other than the horse's regular veterinarian, preferably *your* own veterinarian! Radiographs are a consideration, but realize that most any horse 8 yrs old or better, with any sort of miles on it is going to have some "stuff" in it's joints. So do we all! The big question here is, "Is this horse going to be capable of doing what I plan to ask of it?"

7. Pay for your new endurance horse with cash, a cashier's check, or a money order. It is unreasonable to expect sellers to accept personal checks. There are just too many variables when personal checks come into the picture. Decrease your stress level and that of your seller by preparing to pay with one of the afore mentioned methods.
8. You found "The Horse" and now you've completed the transaction and have "The Horse" home. Give this horse a break! Understand that this horse who looked so great in pictures (or not!), who looked so animated in the video, who was gentle and sweet when you went to look at it, has just undergone a major change of life. Expect your new horse to be a bit depressed, he just left his buddies! Expect him to be a little off his feed, his whole world just changed, monumentally. Give your new horse about two weeks to adjust to his new surroundings. Start him in a space of his own, perhaps sharing a safe fence line with one of your friendlier horses. When they have acquainted, introduce them a little more intimately. Turn them in out in a large paddock together and stick around to make sure no one gets injured. Gradually work your new horse into his new herd. Be patient! Understand that putting a mare with a herd of geldings is potentially going to cause herd dynamics to change. Be very cautious during this time. Stuff happens.
9. If you happen to board your horses at someone else's barn, please be very clear on which horse goes where, and do not deviate from that plan! If you would rather see things be different, stall/pasture wise, wait until all concerned parties are present and have a discussion about who goes where. New horses and resident horses don't tend to initially mix well. Use caution! Do not arbitrarily change the plan if all are not present to consent. Tragedy can occur when people don't stick to the plan! Stuff happens folks.
10. This is probably the most important thing I've learned to do. Have fun horse shopping! You are making a very important decision, but the overall experience should be positive! If things start getting tense then figure out what is wrong and fix it or realize that for some reason, this may not really be the horse for you.

Best of luck in your horse shopping endeavors!

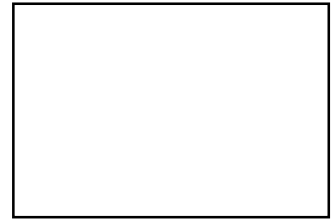
