FROM HWY 97 NORTHBOUND & SOUTHBOUND, TAKE EXIT 138, " MT BACHELOR/COLORADO ST ". FOLLOW MT. BACHELOR SIGNS TO CENTURY DRIVE. LEFT ON CENTURY DRIVE APPROX. 12 MILES TO CAMP, WANOGA SNOW PARK, ON YOUR LEFT.

WHAT IS AN ELEVATOR RIDE?

IN THIS CASE, WHEN YOU START THE 75 MILER, YOU CAN EITHER STOP AT THE FINISH OR (IF THE VET AND RIDER DECIDE THE HORSE IS FIT TO CONTINUE) YOU CAN BUMP UP AND GO ON TO FINISH THE 100 MILER!
