THE MOONLIGHT SCRAMBLE AT WILSON CREEK

WILSON CREEK TRAIL HEAD

Riders can enjoy sandy trails (shoes optional) by the light of the Corn or Harvest full moon. The 5.5-mile and 7.5-mile loops will be marked with LED lights. The ride will start at dusk at the Upper Parking Lot at Wilson Creek, approximately 45 miles southwest of Boise. The trailhead can be accessed from Highway 78 between Marsing and the Highway 45 junction.



This non-competitive trail ride will raise funds for the Murphy Reynolds Wilson Fire District, which is the first responder for all structural fires, wildland fires, and medical emergencies in a 330-square mile rural desert area of Owyhee County.
