



SAGEBRUSH SHUFFLE CTR Sept 19 - 20, 2026 25 miles Oreana, ID

The NW's ONLY stand-alone AHA sanctioned Competitive Trail Ride!!

Saddle Up for the ONLY 2 days of CTR in the NW!! AHA rules.

Lucie Hess and I have agreed to do this one more time 😊 and this time she is dragging Dave along to vet. These are qualifiers for AHA Distance Nationals return to the West in 2028. AHA rules, not NATRC.

Open to all breeds of horse or mule minimum 48 months of age. You do not have to be an AHA member to participate but you do need to know the rules as provided in the AHA Rule book Chapter 13. We chose this date due to Lava Cast canceling for 2026 and we are hopeful Lava Cast will return in the future.

Sept 18 camp opens, check in, vet in. Lucie always goes into details of how the CTR works at the ride meeting Friday PM. We'll discuss trail, timing and pulsing. Our ride veterinarian, D.T. Cross, DVM, will vet all horses Friday PM.



YES you can ride 2 days!! It takes 2 CTR's of a minimum of 25 miles to qualify for AHA Distance Championships, same for ApHC. Here's your opportunity to get qualified in one drive! YES there will be repeat trail, mostly due to water but I'll do the best I can. The plan is a longer loop, vet check, then a short one. The terrain is varied, sand, rocks, sagebrush, hills, no water crossings or gates. LOTS of awards is our plan! Sponsors welcome!!

Early bird entry \$140. Must submit entry with paid \$25 non-refundable deposit no later than September 5. You can pay the entire entry or just the deposit but your entry is not complete without payment. Early discount ends after September 5 and entries are \$160.

We require a minimum of 5 Entries by September 5 for the ride to be a GO. If rider cancels by September 10 a refund minus the \$25 deposit will be given. Online Entries close September 15. You may enter in person after that date. For mail in entries make checks payable to Karen Bumgarner; 15401 Bates Creek Rd, Murphy, ID 83650. Contact Karen for paypal or Lucie for venmo.

Directions - Proceed on Hwy ID 78 to Oreana turn off mile post 43, go a mile, go right on Bates Crk Rd, go 4.7 miles of dirt/gravel to camp 15401. Last 2 miles is narrow but we do it all the time. This is my home so please keep dogs leashed and in your camp, not at my house/yard. Thank you!
